What we do with your information

Registers of Scotland complies with the requirements of data protection legislation. It may retain and share information with other government departments, law enforcement and regulatory bodies including specified anti-fraud organisations under section 68 of the Serious Crime Act 2007. This helps us prevent and detect crime.

Guidance on how to complete the ID forms

If you are completing this form by hand, please complete this form in **black ink** and BLOCK CAPITAL LETTERS. All forms must be signed in black ink.

To guard against fraud, we need to confirm the identity of anyone who is a party to an application for registration where the applicant is not a solicitor or does not have a FAS account.

Each party to a deed and (if not a party to that deed) the applicant must complete a separate ID form which must be verified by an Authorised Certifier. The list of professions which can act as Authorised Certifiers is provided below.

All pages of the form must be returned, however, you need only complete:

PART A - if you are a private individual; or

PART B - if you are acting on behalf of a Corporate Body. If you are acting on behalf of a Corporate Body you must be a director, company secretary or be able to evidence that you are an authorised signatory for that Corporate Body.

You must submit your application for registration no later than 6 months after the ID form has been signed and completed.

Authorised Certifiers

All ID forms must be verified by an Authorised Certifier as an essential part of our fraud prevention process.

Who can be an Authorised Certifier?

Authorised Certifiers must be a person active (not retired) in one of the professions on the list below.

The Authorised Certifier must be able to identify you by inspecting your ID. The Authorised Certifier can carry this out as a free service (for example because you are a friend) or as part of a professional service for example a paid-for service by a GP.

Who cannot be your Authorised Certifier?

Even if they belong to a list of Authorised Certifiers, the following people cannot verify your identity:

- a person or company who has an interest in the application (for example they are also a party to the deed);
- someone related to you by birth or marriage;
- in a relationship with you or live at the same address as you

Will RoS carry out further checks?

Yes. RoS will carry out further checks to applications which may include requesting evidence of the Authorised Certifier's professional status. If we are unable to complete our checks or your application is otherwise incomplete, your application will not be registered.

Supporting documents

You must produce to your Authorised Certifier at least two of the original documents below, one of which must be from List A. Do not provide copies or originals of those documents to Registers of Scotland unless we ask you to provide these.

List A

- Current valid passport;
- EU identity card;
- Current UK, EU, Channel Islands or Isle of Man photocard driving licence (not provisional);
- UK Armed Forces ID

List B

- Current debit or credit card issued in the United Kingdom in the name of the person being identified and signed by them. The person should replicate their signature in front of the verifier so that the signatures should be compared;
- Bank, building society or credit union statement less than 3 months old;
- Postal utility bill less than 3 months old;
- Council tax statement for the current year;
- Council rent book showing the rent paid for the last 3 months;
- Postal mortgage statement for the year just ended;
- Current firearm or shotgun certificate.

CHECKLIST OF APPROVED DOCUMENTS

Evidence of identity required to be exhibited to the Certifier

You must produce at least 2 of the following original documents, one of which must be from list A:

- List A
- Current valid passport
 - EU identity card
 - UK Armed Forces ID card
 - Current UK, EU, Channel Islands or Isle of Man photocard driving licence (not a provisional licence).

- List B
- Council tax bill for the current year
 - Bank, building society or credit union statement
 - Council rent book showing the rent paid for the last three months
 - Utility bill less than three months old (NO mobile telephone bills)
 - Firearm or shotgun certificate
 - Mortgage statement for the mortgage accounting year just ended
 - Current debit or credit card issued in the United Kingdom and signature replicated in the presence of the verifier
